

# Corrugated Hat

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**Construction:** The corrugated hat and cowl set is a simple knit accessory set that plays up the color and texture of a fun bulky weight yarn. Slipped stitches emphasize the brim pattern for a neat, ribbed look.

**Skill level:** Intermediate

**Skills needed:** Knitting in the round, slipping stitches, decreasing by k2tog.

**Dimensions:**

18" circumference (to be worn with 3" negative ease to fit 21-22" head)

8 ½" height

**Gauge:** 15 sts and 20 rows per 4" in slipped stitch seeded rib knit in the round

**Materials:**

- US 10 ½ (6.5 mm) 16" circular needles and double-pointed needles
- 100 yards of bulky weight yarn. *Samples shown in Lion Brand Mandala Watercolors (100 g., 164 yds, 75% Acrylic, 15% Wool, 10% Nylon), teaberry and Berry Meadow Bulky Alpaca Blend yarn (105 yds., 55% alpaca, 30% acrylic, and 15% wool), 1 hank.*
- Stitch Marker
- Yarn needle
- Scissors

**Abbreviations:**

CO: Cast on

k: knit

k2tog: knit two together

p: purl

rnd(s): round(s)

st(s): stitch(es)

sl1 wyib: slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in back

sl1 wyif: slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in front



**Hat Instructions:**

Brim:

CO 72 stitches. Join work to knit in the round, being careful not to twist work. Place stitch marker to mark beginning of rnd.

Round 1 (Set up round): \*k3, p1; repeat from \* to end of rnd

Round 2: p1, \*sl1 wyib, p3; repeat from \* to last 3 sts, sl1 wyib, p2

Round 3: \*k3, sl1 wyif; repeat from \* to end of rnd

Repeat rounds 2-3 six times. Hat measures approx. 2 ½” from CO edge.

Body of Hat:

Rnd 4: k all sts

Repeat round 4 seventeen times (18 rounds worked, hat should 5 ½” tall)

Decrease Rounds:

Begin decrease rounds, switching to double-pointed needles when needed:

Rnd 5: \*k6, k2tog\* repeat around

Rnd 6: k all sts

Rnd 7: \*k5, k2otg\* repeat around

Rnd 8: k all sts

Rnd 9: \*k4, k2tog\* repeat around

Rnd 10: k all sts

Rnd 11: \*k3, k2tog\* repeat around

Rnd 12: k all sts

Rnd 13: \*k2, k2tog\* repeat around

Rnd 14: \*k1, k2tog\* repeat around

Rnd 15: \*k2tog\* repeat to end. 9sts remaining.

Cut yarn, leaving 6” tail. Weave tail through remaining stitches and draw top of the hat closed. Weave in loose ends. Block as desired and wear.
