

Twisted Trellis Hat

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Construction: This hat pattern was first released back in 2012 and is due for an update! It is being re-released along with a new pattern for a companion accessory, the Twisted Trellis Cowl. Knit with worsted weight yarn on US 8 needles, the Twisted Trellis Hat uses slipped and twisted stitches to build a trellis pattern.

Skill level: Beginner-Intermediate

Skills needed: Knitting in the round, slipping stitches, twisting stitches, k2tog and p2tog decreases

Size: Teen/Small Adult (Medium Adult, Large Adult)

Circumference: stretches to fit 18" (20 ½", 23") head circumference

Height: 7", (7 ½", 8")

Gauge: 18 sts and 24 rows per 4" in stockinette stitch knit flat

Materials:

US 8/ 5mm 16" circular needle and double-pointed needles, or size needed to obtain gauge.

130, (150, 180) yards aran weight yarn. *Shown in Lion Brand Basic Stitch Anti Pilling (185 yds, 100 g., 100% acrylic), olive, 1 skein.*

Stitch Marker

Yarn needle

Scissors

Abbreviations:

CO: Cast on

k: knit

k2tog: knit two stitches together

LPT: left purl twist: slip next stitch off needle and hold to front. Purl next stitch. Knit held stitch

p: purl

PSSO: Pass slipped stitch over

p2tog: purl two stitches together

rnd(s): round(s)

RPT: right purl twist: slip next stitch off needle and hold to back. Knit next stitch. Purl held stitch

sl1: Slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in back

Pattern Notes: The twisted trellis pattern chart is included for reference with the instructions. Please refer to the written instructions for pattern repeats.



Instructions:

Brim: Cast on 88, (96, 104) stitches. Join in the round, place stitch marker to mark beginning of round.

Rnd 1: *k1, p1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 2: *s1, p1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Repeat ends 1-2 three, (five, seven) times for a total of 8 (12, 16) rounds complete

Body of Hat: Begin trellis pattern:

Rnd 3: *p3, k2, p3; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 4: *p3, sl1, sl1, p3; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 5: *p2, RPT, LPT, p2; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 6: *p2, sl1, p2, sl1, p2; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 7: *p1, RPT, p2, LPT, p1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 8: *p1, sl1, p4, sl1, p1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 9: *RPT, p4, LPT; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 10: *sl1, p6, sl1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 11: *K1, p6, k1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 12: *sl1, p6, sl1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 13: *LPT, p4, RPT; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 14: *p1, sl1, p4, sl1, p1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

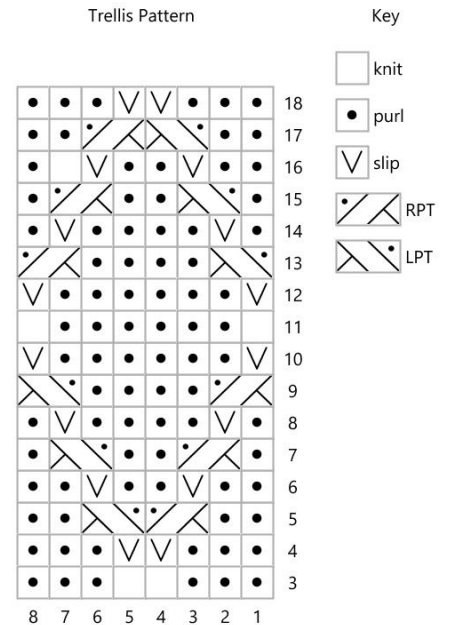
Rnd 15: *p1, LPT, p2, RPT, p1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 16: *p2, sl1, p2, sl1, p2; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 17: *p2, LPT, RPT, p2; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Rnd 18: *p3, sl1, sl1, p3; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Repeat rnds 3-18 once and then repeat rnds 3- 12 once.



Crown: switch to double-pointed needles or preferred method for knitting a small circumference in the round when needed.

Rnd 19: *k1, p2tog, p2, p2tog, k1* repeat around.

Rnd 20: *sl1, p4, sl1* repeat around.

Rnd 21: *k1, p2tog, p2tog, k1* repeat around.

Rnd 22: *sl1, p2, sl1* repeat around.

Rnd 23: *k1, p2tog, k1* repeat around.

Rnd 24: *sl1, p1, sl1* repeat around.

Rnd 25: *sl1, k2tog, pssso* repeat around.

Rnd 26:

Small, Large sizes: *k2tog, k1; repeat from * to last st, k1.

Medium, size only: *k2tog, k1; repeat from * to end of rnd.

Break yarn leaving a 10" tail. Weave tail through remaining stitches to close top of hat. Weave in loose ends. Lightly block. Wear.
