

# Shipyard Scarf

**Construction:** This beginner friendly knitting pattern uses only knit and slipped stitches to create a reversible, warm scarf.

**Skill level:** Beginner

**Skills needed:** knitting, slipped stitches

**Size:** One Size. 12" wide x 80" long

**Gauge:** 21 sts and 27 rows per 4" in stockinette stitch knit flat

## Materials:

US 8 (5.0 mm) straight needles

050 yards of worsted weight wool or wool-blend yarn.

*Sample shown in Lion Brand Wool Ease (197 yards, 80% acrylic, 20% wool) Oxford Grey, 5 skeins.*

Stitch Marker (Optional)

Yarn needle

Scissors

## Abbreviations:

BO: Bind off

CO: Cast on

k: knit

sl1 wyif: slip one stitch purlwise with yarn in front

## Instructions:

CO 63 stitches. *Optional: place stitch marker after knitting 4 or 5 stitches of first row to mark right side.*

Row 1: \*sl1 wyif, k3; repeat from \* to last three stitches, sl1 wyif, k2

Repeat row 1 until scarf measures 80 inches (or desired scarf length), keeping at least 10 yards for BO. BO all stitches loosely. Weave in loose ends and trim. Wet block. Enjoy!
